Recipe

Asparagus Casserole

1-15oz .can asparagus spears (drained)
1-8oz. can water chestnuts (drained and sliced thin) Note*** reserve juice to mix with soup
1- 10- 3/4 oz. Can cream of mushroom soup (undiluted)
1-15oz .can green peas (drained)
Approx 1 cup --grated cheddar cheese to cover mixture.
2 slices of bread toasted -- cut in to strips and then dip in melted butter

Arrange asparagus in bottom of a 1-1/2 qt. casserole
Add sliced chestnuts
Mix chestnut juice with the undiluted soup, add green peas
Pour mixture over top of asparagus and chestnuts, cover with grated cheese
Arrange butter dipped bread strips on top of cheese.

Bake 30 -40 Min. @ 350* oven.
