We have recently restored the IARC station to full operation on bands 80 – 10. There are two functional stations available for use. Contact Dennis Brady 972/790-9026 or any of the Club officers to gain access to the station/equipment.

Recipe

Chocolate Lover’s Cheesepie

3 pack (8 ounces each) cream Cheese, softened

3 eggs

2 cups (12 ounce package) Hershey’s mini Chips

2 tablespoons whipping cream

$\frac{3}{4}$ cup sugar

1 tsp vanilla extract

1 packaged graham cracker crumb crust (9 ounces)

Heat oven to 450 degrees.

Beat cream cheese and sugar in large bowl with mixer until well blended. Add eggs and vanilla; beat well. Stir in $1 \frac{2}{3}$ cups small chocolate chips; pour into crust.

Bake 10 minutes. Without opening oven door, reduce temperature to 250 degrees; continue baking 30 minutes or just until set. Remove from oven to wire rack. Cool completely. Cover; refrigerate until thoroughly chilled. Place remaining 1/3-cup chips and whipping cream in small microwave-safe bowl. Microwave at high (100%) 20 to 30 seconds or just until chips are melted and mixture is smooth when stirred. Cool slightly; spread over top of Cheesepie. Refrigerate 15 minutes or until topping is set. Cover; refrigerate leftover Cheesepie.
