## Recipe

### Diabetic Apple Muffins

1 2/3 C all purpose flour

2 ½ tsp baking powder

½ tsp salt

Sugar Substitute to = 1 tbsp sugar

1 tsp cinnamon

¼ tsp nutmeg

1 egg, slightly beaten

2/3 c skimmed milk

¼ c reduced calorie margarine, melted

1 c apples minced

Sift flour, baking powder, salt, sugar substitute & spices into med mixing bowl. Combine egg, milk and margarine. Add egg mixture to dry ingredients. Blend only until flour is moistened. Fold in apples and pour batter into 12 non stick muffin cups. Filling each 2/3 full. Bake 400° for 30 - 35 minutes.
